Inner Warrior back at clubs nationwide – sign up to host a Warrior Camp

England Rugby’s successful Inner Warrior campaign will return this year, with dates confirmed for the next wave as 31 August to 16 September. The campaign has helped increase women’s rugby participation around the country, with around 5,000 women picking up a rugby ball for the first time and nearly 15,000 attendees across previous camps. The campaign is designed to encourage women to try rugby for the first time and free their Inner Warrior in a fun, sociable and commitment-free environment. The influx of players saw 41 new female club teams established in 2017, and the campaign won a prestigious BT Sports Industry and Women’s Sport Trust #BeAGameChanger award recently.

We are encouraging clubs to sign up to host their own Warrior Camp this August/September. It’s

a great way to kick off the new season and find some new recruits – you could combine it with a social pre-season BBQ? Registration will close on Monday 16 July. Out of season activity and summer camps

Approaching the school holidays, we felt it prudent to remind all CBs and clubs of our guidance for out of season activity and specifically for summer camps. The type of activity for out of season activity including summer camps can be found [here](#), while a practical checklist for those running summer camp activity can be found on section 6.2 in the Age Grade Codes of Practice [here](#).

As a reminder, all clubs, schools and third party providers wishing to run a summer camp need to obtain the approval of the CB as in regulation 15 (15.8.d). CBs may only approve summer camps if the camp organiser can demonstrate:

1. That they have followed the checklist within the Age Grade Codes of Practice (which include safeguarding and medical considerations).
2. That the camp programme activity is in line with the Out of Season Activity Guide
3. That the activity will be compliant with Regulation 15 (with grouping of players, maximum training times, rules of play etc).

We have been in contact with a number of third party providers to detail this information. If you are aware of any providers who are not in line with the regulations please do get in contact. There is a unique opening for a Women and Girls Council Member at the RFU, following Deborah Griffin's appointment as a representative to the World Rugby Council.

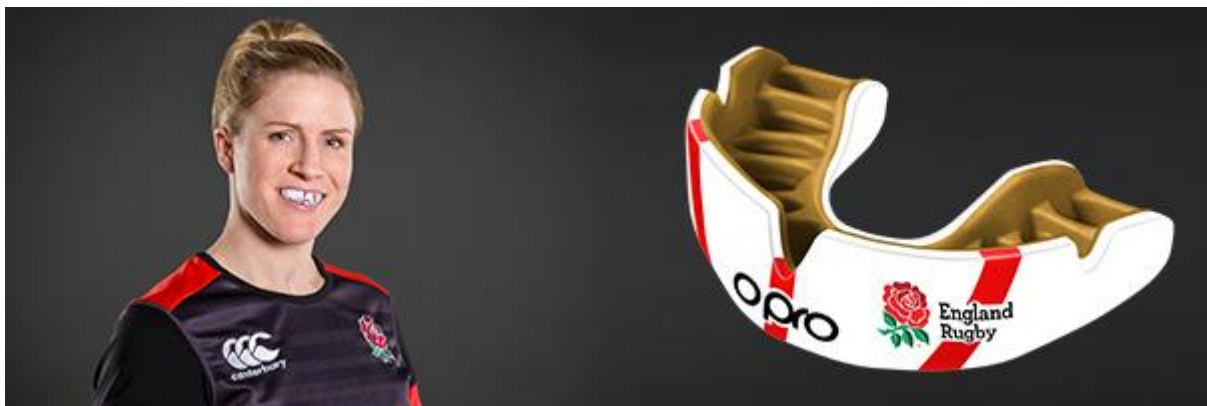

governance of the women and girls game, offering insight, advice and raising any concerns.

Attending representative games and acting as an RFU ambassador within both the women and girls and wider game they will also be a member of the Women's Performance Management Group which oversees the Women's Development to Performance Pathway at England level and the top level of the women's domestic structure.
