Elections to the RFU Council: Guidance notes for CBs and National Representative Bodies

For action: CBs

At a Special General Meeting in November 2017, the RFU's members (clubs, Constituent Bodies (CBs), National Representative Bodies (NRBs), referee societies and Council members) agreed changes to the RFU's constitution. One of the key changes is that Council members will no longer be elected on an annual basis, but will be elected for terms of three years, up to an aggregate maximum of nine years (with some limited exemptions which are explained in the link below).
